

### Feds Adjust 2010 HSA Limits

The federal government has increased the maximum 2010 contribution levels for HSAs along with out-of-pocket spending limits for high-deductible health plans used in conjunction with HSAs.

HSA catch-up contributions	\$1,000 per individual over age 55	\$1,000 per individual over age 55

Maximum out-of-pocket costs	Single - \$5,800 Family - \$11,600	Single - \$5,950 Family - \$11,900
